WASH Programme

School sanitary support through the implementation of a water, sanitation & health (WASH) programme Safe water, toilets and hygiene keep children alive and healthy and girls in education longer.

Phase 1

8 schools, 1 outreach health post Construction of 9 hand washing stations Maintenance 1 hand washing station 8 schools & health post - water tanks Tiling & painting of toilets for 6 schools Over 800+ students directly impacted

Phase 2

7 schools - 600 students impacted 6 newly built hand washing stations 1 newly built toilet Water tanks & pipe fittings for 4 schools Toilet maintenance for 1 school


POST 2015 EARTHQUAKE
