Under her leadership, the Arab Hospitals Federation expanded its network from 650 to over 1,200 member hospitals across 22 Arab countries aligning with the region’s evolving healthcare priorities. Across the Arab world, hospitals collectively serve more than 150 million patients annually through inpatient, outpatient, and emergency services, forming one of the most diverse and fast-evolving healthcare ecosystems globally. The sector is currently witnessing a major transformation, with over 150\$ billion in healthcare investments projected by 2030, including 2.3\$ billion in cross-border initiatives driven by advancements in digital health, AI, and infrastructure modernization. AHF continues to represent and engage its members within this dynamic landscape, advocating for collaboration, sustainability, and innovation.

In 2025, the Federation was officially accredited as an Observer with the World Health Organization (WHO), a historic milestone reinforced by a Memorandum of Understanding signed with WHO EMRO focusing on four vital areas such as quality and patient safety, AI in Healthcare, Hospitals Resilience and Capacity Building development.

She was recognized for two consecutive years (2024 and 2025) by Forbes Middle East magazine as one of the Top 100 Healthcare Leaders, and was also named the “Influential Woman of the Year 2024 in Healthcare Strategy and Collaboration” in the presence of Arab Health Ministers. In addition, she was awarded the National Order of Merit by the Republic of Lebanon in recognition of her contributions to healthcare diplomacy and the unification of Arab countries.

Alice’s influence spans beyond the Arab world. She was nominated to the Higher Advisory Board of the Arab-African Awareness Council and appointed to the Scientific Board of the MediteH Network in Europe, where she supports advancement in precision medicine, digital transformation, and healthcare sustainability.
